John 14:14 - Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!

When we pray we always end it with the words, "in Jesus Name". But what exactly does this mean to pray in Jesus name, and do we pray with this meaning in mind?

When we say, "in Jesus Name", it is not a simple tagging of Jesus name to our request. The true essence of the original word means "His authority". This is how we are to come before the throne room of God... By His authority alone. We are using the authority of the Ruler of all creation to enforce the power of what we have just requested.

There was a centurion, in Jesus' time, that understood this better than most.

Matthew 8:5-10

When Jesus returned to Capernaum, a Roman officer came and pleaded with him, "Lord, my young servant lies in bed, paralyzed and in terrible pain."

Jesus said, "I will come and heal him."

But the officer said, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come into my home. Just say the word from where you are, and my servant will be healed. I know this because I am under the authority of my superior officers, and I have authority over my soldiers. I only need to say, 'Go,' and they go, or 'Come,' and they come. And if I say to my slaves, 'Do this,' they do it."

When Jesus heard this, he was amazed. Turning to those who were following him, he said, "I tell you the truth, I haven't seen faith like this in all Israel!

Did you catch that? The centurion stated, "Just say the Word because Your authority is enough." How great is it to know that just by speaking the name of Jesus we are speaking the very authority of God into our situations.

Matthew 28:18 tells us, Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth."

So, as you pray, don't just mutter the words, "In Jesus Name", without understanding the power behind the words. Pray, not just in His name, but when you pray, do so in the authority of the One who has all authority in heaven and on earth.

There is power in the Name of Jesus!
