I will tell you what it means to me... The cross means the end of sins' power and an overwhelming hope for us as sinners. It completely condemns sin yet at the same time cleanses our souls.

The cross is where Jesus was crucified in our place and where Christ brings resurrection life to all who will believe. The bloodstained cross is horrible and barbaric, but the empty cross fills us with great hope.

The resurrection, on the other hand, is a means to bring about faith in Jesus Christ. If I did not know for certain that Jesus overcame death on the cross and rose from the grave, the gospel has no effect, the church ultimately has no purpose and I have preached in vain. But I am absolutely convinced that Jesus is indeed alive.

I not only believe it because of the evidence found in the Bible, but I believe it because I have had this same resurrection life extended to me. You see, I once was lost but now I am found, was once blind but now I see. Jesus took my life that was once dead in my trespasses and sins and gave me a new life. I have been changed; I am not the man I once was for I have been born again.

This same understanding of the cross and resurrection is available to all who believe. The Bible tells us in Acts 16:31 - "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved". To be saved is truly what all of creation has cried out for. When we have found ourselves lost, or in trouble, or have just made a mess of our lives we daily cry out to be saved in some form or fashion.

Luke 19:10 tells us, "For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost." He came for you, and He came for me. He came so that we might have life, true life, and have it more abundant. As Resurrection morning approaches, let's remember His sacrifice, but also remember that His great sacrifice was for you!


