On Wednesday, June 8 we will recognize our children's missions groups and their accomplishment this year. Join us for a time of celebration in the fellowship hall at 6:00.


Our children and youth will be attending various camps this summer. We also have a team of 12 church members as well as others traveling to Standing Rock with WMU of Virginia. Please


