Wisdom From Above

There are two types of wisdom that we encounter in this life. There is wisdom which produces conflict and division and wisdom which produces peace and unity. There is wisdom that creates a heightened sense of self and wisdom that creates a heightened sense of God and His glory. There is wisdom that leads to bitterness and wisdom that leads to the betterment of all. The wisdom we choose to pursue will determine the life we will experience.

James, the half-brother of Jesus, tells us that the wisdom we choose to pursue and follow is apparent in the way in which we live our lives. James tells us in 3:13, "Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom." In other words, wisdom from above (from God) produces meekness which is evident in one's conduct. He states that God's wisdom is, "pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere. A harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace (3:17-18)."

The characteristics James identifies ought to help us recognize the source of our wisdom and that of others. If we do not see these characteristics exhibited in our own lives, then we ought to reflect on the wisdom we have chosen to follow. The promise we have is that when we choose to pursue and follow the wisdom of God, we will experience peace and righteousness even in the midst of war and depravity.

Let us choose to pursue the wisdom of God revealed to us in His Word. Let us choose to follow His wisdom even if that means wading into uncharted waters. Let us choose to follow God's wisdom and expect Him to produce in us the characteristics found in this passage from James. Let us conduct ourselves in meekness (power under control) as a product of God's wisdom reigning in our hearts and minds. Let the world, gripped by the wisdom of the world, see a people who live in the world in such a way as to demonstrate a better wisdom. Let us be the living expression of wisdom from above.


