John 15:18-21 - "If the world hates you, remember that it hated me first. The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you. Do you remember what I told you? 'A slave is not greater than the master.' Since they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you. And if they had listened to me, they would listen to you. They will do all this to you because of me, for they have rejected the one who sent me."

I have read so much about the church being persecuted lately. But this doesn't take God by surprise. Jesus told us that since they persecuted Him we can expect persecution also; since they hated Him they will hate us.

Not very comforting is it? The church, as a whole, hasn't seen persecution much up to this point, at least not in America. But if we are true believers, true followers, then we should be expecting this to happen.

But there is solace in knowing that the God whom we serve has promised us a gift in John 14:27 - "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid".

You see, no matter how bad the world might become, Jesus has promised us a peace that passes all understanding. So, as the world continues to persecute those who follow after Christ, stand firm in the faith, and don't be troubled or afraid for God is with us.
