

Why would he do this? Because, before anything and everything, God knew all about us and our desperate need for Christ to die for us.


What an amazing gift! A gift made possible because, "God loved"!

Annie Armstrong once said, "What a glorious thing it is to be a co-worker with God in winning the world for Christ." 
